

LIST OF COMMON SUBORDINATORS

When you see a sentence that begins with one of these subordinators, BE CAREFUL. These words appear at the beginning of subordinate clauses, and subordinate clauses cannot stand by themselves – they are not complete sentences. Make sure that all your subordinate clauses are attached to independent clauses.
